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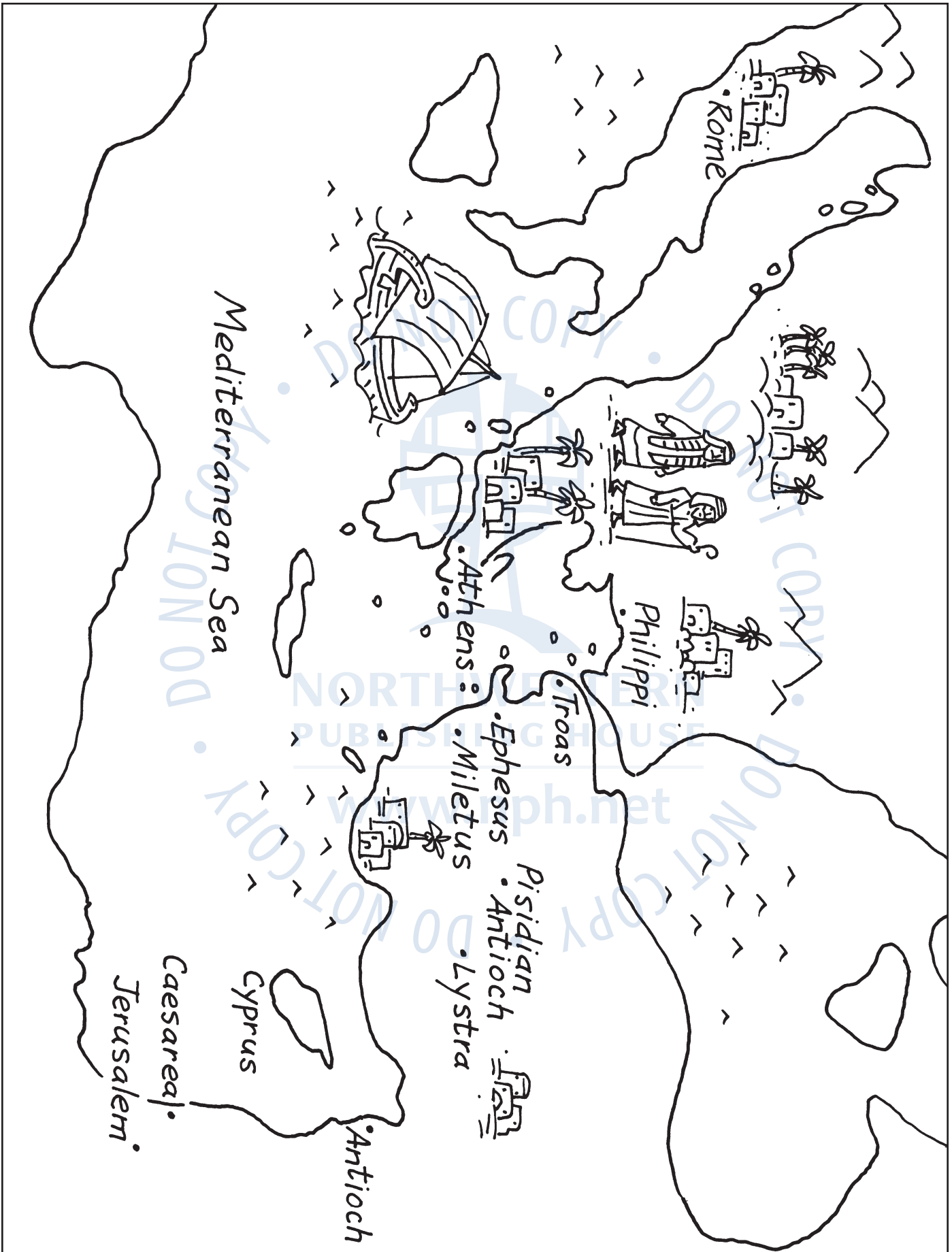
Dear Parent,

Please use this sheet to reinforce and apply what your child has learned about the Word of God. Together with your child, use the prayer to worship our wonderful God.

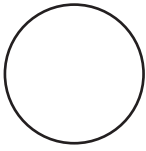
May God bless you as you carry out the exciting task of Christian parenting!



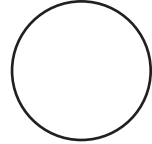

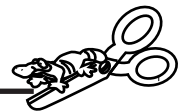
